EXTENSION OF AGREEMENT

This EXTENSION OF AGREEMENT is made and entered into on August 21, 2020, by and between TOHOKU UNIVERSITY (JAPAN) and INDIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY BOMBAY (INDIA).

Based on the Agreement for Cultural, Educational and Scientific Cooperation and Memorandum of Understanding on Student Exchange between Tohoku University and Indian Institute of Technology Bombay, commencing on August 21, 2000, the two institutions agree to extend the Agreement for five (5) additional years. This action will extend the validity of the Agreement and MoU until August 20, 2025.

All contents of the current Agreement for Cultural, Educational and Scientific Cooperation and Memorandum of Understanding on Student Exchange will remain in effect with the following modifications:

Both parties agree to the following amendments to the Agreement for Cultural, Educational and Scientific Cooperation and Memorandum of Understanding on Student Exchange:

This Agreement will be reviewed not less than six months prior to the natural termination of the current memorandum and may be extended or renewed in mutual accordance. At any time, the terms of this Agreement may be amended by mutual agreement in a written notice. This memorandum may be terminated by either university with a six-month notice. No applications shall be considered after this notice; however, the universities will continue to fulfill their obligations with the accepted exchange students until the completion of their study plans.

This Agreement may be executed in two counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original and all of which, taken together, will constitute one and the same agreement. It is understood that the parties need not sign the same counterpart. The counterparts will both be written in the English language.

For the purposes of this Agreement, signatures transmitted by facsimile, Portable Document Format (PDF), or any other electronic means intended to preserve the original graphic and pictorial appearance of this Agreement will be deemed an original signature and will constitute effective execution of this Agreement sufficient to bind each party. Photocopies of any such electronically transmitted signatures will be deemed the same.



Memorandum of Understanding on Student Exchange between Indian Institute of Technology Bombay, India and Tohoku University, Japan

The academic exchange between Indian Institute of Technology Bombay and Tohoku University, as it relates to the exchange of students, will be implemented as follows:

1. The students participating in the exchange program during the term of the agreement will be selected initially by the home institution, and the host institution will make final admission decision in each case.
2. Each institution will enroll no more than five students from the other side, each year. The actual number of students exchanged will be determined each year by mutual in advance consultation.
3. The period of enrollment of the students at the host institution will not exceed one year.
4. The students will continue as candidates for degrees at their home institution and will not be candidates for degrees at the host institution.
5. Travel expenses, cost of living or other necessary expenses incurred by the students will be the responsibility of the individual students or their sponsors. This does not preclude applications for scholarships from independent institutions.
6. The field of study for each student will be such that the host institution can appoint a qualified advisor and provide appropriate courses of study.
7. In order to carry out foreign study successfully, each student will possess the level of language ability requested by the host institution to complete the appropriate course of study.
8. The host institution will exempt application, matriculation, and tuition fees for the students from the other institution.
9. Each institution agrees to provide to the other side, with the documentation of course work completed by the students and the appropriate academic information on their performance. Based on these reports, the home institution will determine the appropriate number of credits to be given to the students according to its rules and regulations.
10. The host institution will assist the students in finding adequate housing on or near the campus.



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Agreement for Cultural, Educational and Scientific Cooperation between Indian Institute of Technology Bombay, India and Tohoku University, Japan

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote further international cooperation between India and Japan, Indian Institute of Technology Bombay and Tohoku University join in the following agreement on cultural, educational and scientific cooperation.


Both institutions shall cooperate in fields of teaching and research to be agreed upon. Cooperation in other areas may be arranged by mutual agreement. Within the fields of study to be mutually designated, both institutions agree to the following general forms of cooperation:

- (1) Joint research activities.
- (2) Exchange of invitation to scholars for lectures, talk, and participation in conferences, colloquia, and symposia.
- (3) Exchange of information in fields of interest to both institutions.
- (4) Exchange of faculty and students for study, education and research.

Themes of joint activities and the conditions for utilizing the results achieved and arrangements for specific visits, exchanges, and other forms of cooperation will be arrangements will have to be negotiated for each specific case and will depend on the availability of funds.

This agreement will be effective upon the date of signature by the representatives of the institutions. This agreement can be modified by mutual agreement during term of the agreement. Unless review of this agreement is required, it will automatically be extended every 5 years.

The agreement is made in duplicate in English, both being equally authentic.
